FALL 2009 ADMISSION

The internet admission application for fall 2009 will be available as of **January 13th**, on our Web site: <http://sram.omnivox.ca>.

You have recently received a copy of the *Table of Available Programs – Admission Fall 2009*. Applicants need to use that document when applying online because it includes the table of particularities and prerequisites for each program of studies. It is a reference tool they will need throughout the whole application for admission process. As well, our regular Web site (www.sram.qc.ca / *home page* section) will keep them informed as to modifications, corrections and other news.

APPLICANTS DEADLINE AND INSTRUCTIONS

The admission applications must be completed by the latest at **11:59 p.m. on March 1, 2009**. All required documents, including the payment, must arrive at SRAM by that deadline. Application fees are \$30 and are non refundable. Many payment methods are offered to applicants: by credit card directly on our secure Web site, by electronic bill payment, or by mail (certified cheque or postal money order). Also, by consulting our Web site, the applicants can validate the documents to be sent to SRAM, if needed, and have access at any moment to the menu *Status of your application*. All completed applications that have been received on time will be evaluated at the same time by the various cégeps.

Late applications

SRAM will automatically push to the next round all applications that have been completed after the deadline. However, applicants must make sure that places are still available and, if not, make a new choice.

Documents to be sent to SRAM

Applicants who have to send documents to SRAM must use the **special fax number** that is included on the transmission receipt which must accompany all documents. It also appears online on the page *Application for admission transmitted to SRAM*. SRAM has the responsibility to collect all the documents that make up the applications for admission.

Academic grades

Academic grades are sent out electronically. Only applicants who study at private schools or at school boards that do not benefit from the electronic transfer service with SRAM must send out their documents themselves. In that case, students will have to send their report cards and must include the transmission receipt when faxing this information to SRAM. **If a report card already sent to SRAM has been modified, the school has the responsibility to send the new report card.** If, for the same applicant, SRAM receives an electronic report card as well as a paper copy, **only the electronic version will be evaluated.**

NEWS AND MODIFICATIONS TO TABLE OF AVAILABLE PROGRAMS FALL 2009

N.B.: The SRAM-OMNIVOX system has been updated with these modifications.

- In spite of what can be read on the *Table of Available Programs – Admission Fall 2009*, the **Institut de technologie agroalimentaire of Saint-Hyacinthe** will be offering at fall 2009 the program **152.21, *Farm management and technology in the pathway DEP-DEC*** for students with a DEP in Dairy cow or in Beef.
- At **Collège Ahuntsic**, the names for the profiles of the program **200.B0, *Science***, are the following:
 - **Sciences de la santé et de la vie**
 - **Sciences pures et appliquées**
 - Profil passe-partout
- At **Cégep André-Laurendeau**, the profile “**Environnement Gaïa**” of the program **200.B0, *Science***, is replaced by the profile **Environnement et santé**.
- In the column of the particular admission conditions, the code A should appear on the line of the program **110.B0, *Denturology***, since **applicants in this program at Collège Édouard-Montpetit may be invited to selection tests**.
